As part of its mission to promote excellence in nursing education, the NLN Foundation is partnering with CampusRN to offer scholarships to members of 15 NLN Constituent Leagues. Each of these constituent leagues will be given \$500 to award to their members for professional development or graduate education scholarships.

The participating constituent leagues for 2008 include: Alabama, Connecticut, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Missouri, Nebraska, New Jersey, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia, and Wisconsin. Each constituent league will set its own criteria for awarding the scholarship funds.
